



Professor H.D. Sankalia Young Archaeologist Award

Professor H.D. Sankalia Young Archaeologist Award is given every year to a young archaeologist (below 40 years of age on the first of January of the year) specialising in any branch of archaeology, preferably the prehistory, protohistory, and palaeoenvironment of South Asia. The Award will be given for the best research paper presented during the Annual Conference of the Society. The Awardee will get a token honorarium of one thousand rupees and a certificate. The selected paper shall be published in *Man and Environment* in the earliest subsequent issue.

Scholars desiring to compete for the Award will submit one hard copy of their research paper (and a soft copy by mail) complete in all respects, to the General Secretary of the Society before the date announced for the year. The paper must accompany the declaration that the work is original (format is given below).

The paper should be based on original research data or on a new interpretation of existing data. The paper offered will be screened by a committee of two experts nominated by the Executive Committee of the Society. A maximum of three papers approved by the screening committee shall be presented during the Conference.

The scholars shall personally present their papers during the Conference. A Committee of three experts chosen by the Executive Committee of the Society from among the Society's members present during the Conference will select the best paper for the Award. The Society shall pay to all those called for presentation, sleeper class return train fare from the place of his/her residence to the place of the Conference.
